

Discipline: **TRUMPET**

The panel of judges in this discipline is composed of three eminent trumpet teachers and artists (two trumpeters and a horn player).

Candidates competing in TRUMPET Category A-F must play a **listed** piece from memory.

Category A: 2013 and younger

- One of the listed pieces:
 - D. Cullen: Sailing
 - E. Lesieur: Perce-Neige
 - F. Kastel: Claire! On Trompette
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate should be from 5 to 7 minutes.

Category B: Year 2011 - 2012

- One of the listed pieces:
 - J. Porret: Concertino br. 19
 - H. A. Vandercook: Altair
 - J. N. Hummel: Indian rondo
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate should be from 8 to 10 minutes.

Category C: Year 2009 - 2010

- One of the listed pieces:
 - H. A. Vandercook: Arcturus
 - V. Šelokov: Koncert (for children)
 - J. Porret: Concertino br. 20
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate should be from 10 to 12 minutes.

Category D: Year 2007 - 2008

- One of the listed pieces:
 - G. Balay: Andante et Allegro
 - P. Baldassari: Sonata No. 1 in B-flat major
 - C. Grundmann: Conversation for Cornet
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate should be from 12 to 15 minutes.

Category E: Year 2005 - 2006

- One of the listed pieces:
 - J. Ed. Barat: Fantaisie en Mi b
 - G. Alary: Morceau de Concours
 - G. Balay: Prélude et Ballade
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate should be from 15 to 18 minutes.

Category F: Year 2003 - 2004

- One of the listed pieces:
 - J. Hubeau: Sonata, I.st. Sarabande, II.st. Intermede
 - J. Ed. Barat: Andante et Scherzo
 - F. Thomé: Fantaisie
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate should be from 18 to 20 minutes.

WWB Grand Prix: TRUMPET

1988 and younger

In each round one piece must be played from memory.

Round 1

- Obligatory piece:
 - J. Haydn: Trumpet Concerto in E-flat major (played on an E or B flat trumpet)
- Choose one of the following sonatas/sonatinas for trumpet and piano:
 - P. Hindemith: Sonata for trumpet and piano
 - J. Françaix: Sonatina for trumpet and piano
 - B. Martinů: Sonatina for trumpet and piano
 - S. Šulek: Sonata for trumpet and piano
 - G. Antheil: Sonata for trumpet and piano
 - H. Stevens: Sonata for trumpet and piano
 - K. Kennan: Sonata for trumpet and piano

Round 2

- One free choice piece for trumpet solo.
- Choose one of the following concertos for piccolo trumpet:
 - J. W. Hertel: Trumpet Concerto No. 1 in E-flat major
 - J. W. Hertel: Trumpet Concerto No. 3 in D major
 - G. Ph. Telemann: Trumpet Concerto in D major (TWV 51:D7)
 - L. Mozart: Trumpet Concerto in D major
 - J. M. Molter: Trumpet Concerto No. 1 in D major
 - G. Tartini: Trumpet Concerto in D major
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate should be from 25 to 45 minutes.
