# Discipline: SAXOPHONE

The panel of judges in this discipline is composed of three eminent teachers and artists. Candidates competing in any of the SAXOPHONE Categories A-F must play at least one piece from memory.

## Category A: 2012 and younger

- One of the listed pieces is obligatory:
  - o J. M. Damase: Vacances (Billadout)
  - o J.D. Michat: Squaw (Martin)
  - o E. Bozza: Reves d"enfant (Leduc)
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 6 minutes.

## Category B: Year 2010 - 2011

- One of the listed pieces is obligatory:
  - o J. Avignon: Spiritual et danse exotique (M. Braun)
  - o R. Ares: Diptique (Scherzando Music. Publ.)
  - o G. Samyn: Variet song (Billaudot)
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 8 minutes.

## Category C: Year 2008 - 2009

- One of the listed pieces is obligatory:
  - o D. Dondeyne: Voyages imaginaries (Combre) (five own-choice movements)
  - o P. Demillac: Sicilenne et Tarantelle (Combre)
  - o C. H. Joubert: Barocco (Combre)
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 12 minutes.

## Category D: Year 2006 - 2007

- One of the listed pieces is obligatory:
  - o J. M. Defaye: Ampelopsis (Leduc)
  - o E. Bozza: Prelude et divertissement (Leduc)
  - o P. Maurice: Tableaux de Provence (Henry Lemoine) (3 movements)
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 15 minutes.

## Category E: 2003 - 2005

- Own-choice sonata
- One solo piece

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 20 minutes.

## Category F: Year 2002 - 1998

- One of the listed pieces is obligatory:
  - o Fernande Decruck: SONATA
  - o Alfred Desenclos: PRÉLUDE, CADENCE ET FINALE
  - o Lucie Robert: CADENZA
  - o Florent Schmitt: LÉGENDE
  - o Edison Denisov: SONATA
  - o William Albright: SONATA
  - o Takashi Yoshimatsu: FUZZY BIRD SONATA
  - o Jindřich Feld: SONATA FOR ALTO SAXOPHONE
  - o Anđelko Klobučar: SONATA
- One free choice solo piece.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 25min.

## **WWB Grand Prix: SAXOPHONE**

1988 and younger

## Round 1

- Obligatory piece:
  - o Frank Martin: BALLADE for Alto Saxophone
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 25 minutes.

## Round 2

- Obligatory piece:
  - o Branko Lazarin: Tri stavka za alt saksofon solo (Cantus) (Three movements for Alto Saxophone Solo)
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

One of the free choice pieces must be a piece which can be performed with an orchestra. At the competition, this piece shall be performed with piano accompaniment. Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 40 minutes.
