# Discipline: CLARINET

The panel of judges in this discipline is composed of three eminent clarinet teachers and clarinet players.

Competitors in **all categories and in each Grand Prix discipline** are required to play one piece by memory.

# Category A: Year 2015 and younger

• Free choice programme.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 6 minutes.

#### Category B: Year 2013 - 2014

• Free choice programme.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 8 minutes.

#### **Category C**: Year 2011 - 2012

• Free choice programme.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 12 minutes.

## **Category D**: Year 2009 – 2010

- One of the listed pieces:
  - o H. Rabaud: Solo de Concours
  - o Coquard: Melodie et Scherzetto, Op. 68
  - o J. Ed. Barat: Piece in sol mineur
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.
- Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 15 minutes.

## **Category E**: Year 2007 – 2008

- One of the listed pieces:
  - o J. Mouquet: Solo de Concours
  - o J. Semler-Collery: Rêverie et Scherzo
  - o E. Bozza: Claribel
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.
- Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 20 minutes.

#### **Category F**: Year 2005 – 2006

- One of the listed pieces:
  - o Messager: Solo de Concours
  - o C. M. Widor: Introduction et rondo
    - C. Debussy: Première rhapsodie
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.
- Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 25 minutes.

# **VWB Grand Prix: CLARINET**

1990 and younger

In each round, candidates must play one piece from memory.

#### Round 1

- One of the listed pieces:
  - o G. Donizetti: Studio Primo
  - o I. Stravinsky: Three pieces
  - o B. Kovács: Hommage á Richard Strauss
  - o B. Kunc: Pastoralna Fantazija
- One free choice piece.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 12 minutes.

#### Round 2

- One of the listed pieces:
  - o W. A. Mozart: Concerto K622
  - o L. Spohr: Concerto No. 1 in C Minor, Op. 26
  - o A. Copland: Concerto
  - o J. Françaix: Concerto
- The rest of the programme shall consist of free choice pieces.

Total performance time per candidate must not exceed 45 minutes.
